



Card Basket with Handle

This basket holds up to 15 cards and envelopes, making it a substantial gift as well as an economical one, since it uses just one sheet of cardstock or DSP with no leftovers.

Cut a sheet of 12x12 Double-Sided Paper (DSP) to 9x12. Score at one and a half inches along both long sides. Score at one and five inches from both short sides.

Fold over the one inch pieces to show the design along the outer edge and reinforce the basket. Adhere with SNAIL. Snip up to the score line from the outside edge on the five inch scores. Fold into box. Secure sides with Sticky Strip.

Create the handle by scoring at one and two inches the long way down the remaining 3x12 inch DSP strip. Fold inward and secure with SNAIL. Attach the handle to the short sides of the box with a brad.

Decorate the box as desired with ribbon, Hodgepodge Hardware, felt flowers, etc.
