Instructions for Card Carry Case

Supplies needed:
1 8.5x11 sheet of cardstock, any color
Stamps and ink as desired
Coordinating cardstock for a tag
Coordinating ribbon for handles
1/8 inch hole punch
Sticky Strip
Paper cutter with scoring blade

- 1. Stamp design all over the cardstock as desired.
- 2. Score the cardstock at 4.5 and 7.5 inches on the 11-inch side.
- 3. Score the cardstock at 1.25 on either side on the 8.5-inch side.
- 4. Fold up the two big front and back sides. Cut up the bottom side score marks just to the fold to create a bottom flap that will be inside the case.
- 5. Fold in the sides and attach with Sticky Strip.
- 6. Punch four holes, one in each of the front corners, on the two big front and back sides.
- 7. Thread ribbon through the holes to make handles, tying in a big enough knot that it won't slip through (thread your tag through the handle as well).
- 8.**To turn your open case into a purse:** before you add the handles, cut a piece of coordinating card-stock 4x6 inches and round all four corners. Score at 1.75, 2, and 2.25 inches. Attach the back of the lid to the case with Sticky Strip and use a Velcro dot to close it in the front. Punch one hole in the side panel on each of the sides. Use the ribbon to make one handle instead of two.
