Carousel Notes Purse

- 1. Dry-emboss one Carousel Note on the light table as desired using the coordinating Pick A Petal brass template.
- 2. Take three of the chocolate envelopes and fit the flaps inside each other. Tuck the ends of the double-stitched ribbon handle inside the edges and adhere with Sticky Strip.
- 3. Trim out more of the opening of the envelopes using the Round Tab punch inserted partway, to make it easier to get the pages out.
- 4. Fold the embossed Carousel Note in half and put a large patterned brad where the purse "clasp" would go (ours is non-functional). Attach over the "hinge" of the purse using dimensionals.
- 5. Insert brads into the Hodgepodge Hardware and trim off ends if needed. Attach to cardfront using Sticky Strip (don't want the pages to catch on the inside, so not sticking it through). Stamp a saying if desired and punch with the Designer Label punch to insert in the hardware.
- 6. Stamp a saying for the inside and a flower spray on the photo mat using the ink that coordinates with your Carousel Note.
- 7. Punch out scallops, flowers, pull-tabs and photo corners from coordinating cardstock and decorate the inside of the purse and the two pullout pieces. Attach decorations with dimensionals. Adhere brads as shown through the flower centers.
- 8. Use the Spiral Notebook punch to create faux notebook paper. Stamp as desired. Our sample uses Live Your Dreams.
- To complete your scrapbook purse—add pictures and journaling.
